From Sun Valley Caravan Park you can stroll to Rhuddlan Village as you take in the breath taking historic views of Rhuddlan Castle, where you will find local amenities including takeaway's, pubs, a beauty salon and hairdresser's.

Excellent river fishing is available in the River Clwyd which provides a beautiful boundary to one side of the caravan park, while the imposing shape of Rhuddlan Castle (which has stood guard over this region of Wales for more than 700 years) makes a beautiful backdrop as you enjoy a glass of wine on your veranda.

The town of Rhuddlan sits in the county of Denbighshire, North Wales. It lies on the banks of the River Clwyd to the east of Abergele, north of St Asaph and to the south of Rhyl. Rhuddlan is renowned for both its Edwardian Castle and the Church of St Mary, both of which stand on the banks of the River Clwyd. Rhuddlan Castle is one of the "Iron Ring of Castles" built by the English King Edward 1 to suppress the Welsh and never fails to impress.
